32 **Other Than Buildings.** The Plan Commission will discuss and may act to refer to the Village  
33 Board the Ordinance to Repeal and Re-Create Section 745-7 C. (1) and 745-6 A. of the Village  
34 of Fox Point Zoning Code Concerning Garages, Accessory Buildings and certain Structures  
35 Other Than Buildings

36 Laurie and Byron Vielehr, 7944 Beach Dr., Fox Point; voiced their concerns about the  
37 ordinance potentially be too restrictive.

43 *Accessory Buildings and certain Structures Other Than Buildings to clarify an*  
44 *ambiguity to ensure the ordinance is not restrictive.*
