Dear Resident:

I am writing on behalf of the Village of Fox Point to inform you that the Village will be undertaking the rehabilitation of the sanitary sewer main located within the Village's right-of-way and which is in close proximity to your house. These activities are being performed because we have discovered that the physical condition of the sanitary sewer main is deteriorated and is in need of repair.

The Contractor will rehabilitate approximately 5,500 feet of deteriorated sanitary sewer main line in different areas of the Village of Fox Point. Mainly, rehabilitation of the sanitary sewer main will be done by installing a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP liner) inside the existing pipe without any digging or surface disturbance.

The sanitary sewer main rehabilitation activities are tentatively scheduled to begin the week of May 4, 2020 and last a total of approximately one month. However, each segment of pipe is typically completed in one or two days before moving on to the next segment. During rehabilitation, you may experience a strong plastic smell; this is normal and is the pipe being cured with hot water or steam. To cut down on the odor, you should pour water down your floor drains and basement sinks. As we get closer to the date on which sanitary sewer rehabilitation work will commence, the Contractor will notify you one day in advance so that you may plan accordingly.
