ADMINISTRATION

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

POLICE DEPARTMENT

1. Officers responded to a medical call for a report of a subject who cut themselves and was severely bleeding. The Officer responded and applied a tourniquet to stop the bleeding, prior to the North Shore Fire Department's arrival. The subject was transported to the hospital for further medical care.
2. Officers received reports of an Entry in Progress. The resident reported a subject had attempted to enter their vehicle which was left in the driveway. The subject was last seen fleeing the scene and was not located.
3. An officer responded to a Theft complaint. The resident reported their credit card was used to purchase items from several online stores without their permission. The officer is currently investigating the fraudulent charges.
4. Officers responded to report of a suicidal subject who had taken a large number of various medications. The subject was transported to the hospital for medical treatment and is receiving mental health treatment.

In response to the COVID-19 crisis, Milwaukee County's Office of Emergency Management created the Unified Emergency Operations Center (UEOC) to coordinate efforts among fire, law enforcement, EMS, public health and government functions across the county and its municipalities. This does not mean you are registering to be vaccinated, but you will receive updates on the vaccination efforts in Milwaukee County.
